



Yes, you can arrive by boat or even go out for sunset photos on the water. Anything is possible.











The majority of my clients have commented how much they love this shot. This might be something you might want to let your photographer know if this is something you wish for them to capture on your big day.






### **Family Portraits on Deck**

(That's where the ceremony was located)


My team along with the catering team typically will move the ceremony chair inside immediately following the ceremony to make room for cocktail hour and making it possible for these types of family/friend photos.





#### Family Portraits on the Beach

This shot all depends on if there is a low or high tide the day of your event. These conditions can change by the hour at Travis Marina. It's best to look up the tide conditions in advance if you are hoping for this backdrop on the beach. Also, there is no way to know if trash will be washed up as this is something that the venue does not monitor or remove for each event. Best to keep this as a "I'd like if possible, idea."










The Groomsmen are not allowed to hang out upstairs, but we can sneak upstairs for a quick photo opportunity.


